For those wishing to commune at the Lords Table with us today: The Lutheran practice of close Communion attempts to prevent a person from eating and drinking judgment on himself (1 Corinthians 11:23–30). Thus, attendance at the Lords Supper implies a four-level commitment to Christ. We believe that communicants must: (1) be baptized Christians; (2) accept the real presence of Christs body in the bread and His blood in the wine; (3) confess and repent of ones sins and trust that God offers complete forgiveness of those sins in this Sacrament; and (4) share oneness of faith, doctrine and practice among those who commune. Those wishing to commune with us today who have not done so previously, please see the pastor or an elder before the service begins. (Grape juice is available for those who do not drink alcohol, and gluten-free wafers are available upon request.)

We fail to proclaim the great value You give to life, Father, have mercy on us and forgive us for Jesus' sake.
- God has had mercy upon us! Jesus, "for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross" (Hebrews 12:2). The hands of God that created you stretched out in love upon the cross to pay the price for all your sins. Therefore, be assured that God's hand of mercy is upon you, and it is my joy, in the stead and by the command of our risen Lord Jesus, to forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.
