Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ!

<sup>36</sup> “Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?” <sup>37</sup> And [Jesus] said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. <sup>38</sup> This is the great and first commandment. <sup>39</sup> And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. <sup>40</sup> On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets,” (Matthew 22:36-40 ESV).

In recent news stories out of Louisiana, the legislature passed a law requiring the Ten Commandments to be posted in the classrooms of all public schools. Whether this law will hold up in the courts is another story, as many argue it is unconstitutional. The lawmakers in Louisiana passed this law partly because they believe our schools and America as a country were founded on the Ten Commandments and that they should be posted, if nothing else, as a nod to our history. My question to you, along with all Americans who see the Ten Commandments as foundational to our lives and American history: Do you know the Ten Commandments by heart? My guess is that 3-5% of Americans know them, but I have no statistics to back this up. So, if the Ten Commandments are so vital to our lives, why do we know so little about them?

A lawyer (a person who interpreted the law of the Old Testament) approached Jesus and asked what the most important commandment is. It was a trap to see if Jesus would pick one part of the law as important at the expense of another. Today, we sometimes see this in politics when a reporter asks a “gotcha” question that cannot be answered satisfactorily. However, Jesus is God, and so He has the perfect answer. He says to love God with your whole being and to love your neighbor as yourself. I’m not sure about you, but that is a very simple summary of the Ten Commandments that I can remember by heart!

Please do not take this as an encouragement to never learn the Ten Commandments, because you cannot know what it means to love God and your neighbor without understanding each commandment. The main point is that the Ten Commandments will not do much

posted on the wall, but they will do amazing things when we learn them by heart and carry them with us always. The commandments are based on love—love for God and love for neighbor. When love becomes the driving force, lives change for the better. When love is the driving force, powerful things occur, like God the Father sending His Son to die for us and forgive us. Love sent our Savior to bring us forgiveness, life, and salvation.

Please take the time to learn the Ten Commandments by heart, along with their meaning as found in Luther’s Small Catechism. Once you have done that, you are free to sum up the Ten Commandments by saying, “Love God and love your neighbor.”

<sup>36</sup> “Maestro, ¿cuál es el mandamiento más importante de la ley?” <sup>37</sup> —“Ama al Señor tu Dios con todo tu corazón, con todo tu ser y con toda tu mente” —le respondió Jesús—. <sup>38</sup> Éste es el primero y el más importante de los mandamientos. <sup>39</sup> El segundo se parece a éste: “Ama a tu prójimo como a ti mismo.” <sup>40</sup> De estos dos mandamientos dependen toda la ley y los profetas,” (Mateos 22:36-40 NVI).

En noticias recientes de Louisiana, la legislatura aprobó una ley que requiere que los Diez Mandamientos se coloquen en las aulas de todas las escuelas públicas. Que esta ley se sostenga en los tribunales es otra historia, ya que muchos argumentan que es inconstitucional. Los legisladores de Louisiana aprobaron esta ley en parte porque creen que nuestras escuelas y Estados Unidos como país se fundaron sobre los Diez Mandamientos y que deberían publicarse, al menos, como un guiño a nuestra historia. Mi pregunta para usted, junto con todos los estadounidenses que ven los Diez Mandamientos como fundamentales para nuestras vidas y la historia de Estados Unidos: ¿Conoce los Diez Mandamientos de memoria? Supongo que entre el 3 y el 5% de los estadounidenses los conocen, pero no tengo estadísticas que lo respalden. Entonces, si los Diez Mandamientos son tan vitales para nuestras vidas, ¿por qué sabemos tan poco acerca de ellos?

Un abogado (una persona que interpretaba la ley del Antiguo Testamento) se acercó a Jesús y le preguntó cuál era el mandamiento más importante.

## THROUGH MY WINDOW



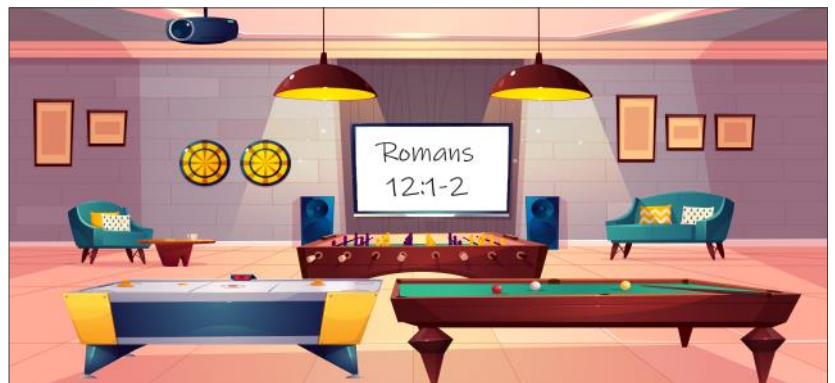
